A few words about our speakers

Martin Beck is interested in the structure and function of large macromolecular assemblies by combining biochemical approaches, proteomics and cryo-electron microscopy.

Christian Beisel investigates the molecular interplay of Polycomb and Trithorax group (PcG/TrxG) proteins, and their role in chromatin based gene regulation, governing lineage commitment, maintenance and stem cell biology.

Joerg Stelling works on integration of cellular regulation across metabolism, signal transduction and gene regulation by doing structural network analysis.
